# Is there a way to resend a transaction across an interface?

There is a very usable function available starting with RadPlus 4.5. It is a simple way to resend a transaction across an interface. The function is "Interface Force Transmission."

In RadPlus, click: the Setup icon, "Interface Items" folder and double click "Interface Force Transmission." The user will be prompted for three fields:

- "What To Send." Click the drop down menu to select what data you would like to send. If a selection is not available, although we recommend sending only results, contact the Help Desk at (800) 353-4348 to build the appropriate "Interface Request Dictionary" record.
- "Interface." Select the appropriate interface.
- "Data Entry." This field is dependent on what was selected in the "What to Send" field. For example, it may prompt for a procedure ID, encounter number, or a patient name /MRN. Select the data that needs to be sent.

After clicking the "Send" button, the transaction is sent to the appropriate interface.

# **Support Issues**

We've just changed our modem phone number. Who should we contact at Dynamic?

Dynamic utilizes NT Remote Access Service (RAS) with modems and/or the Internet along with PC Anywhere to access your servers and certain workstations in order to provide technical support.

Changes to RAS, workstation logon and PC Anywhere passwords as well as RAS modem phone numbers associated with our technical support must be communicated to our Help Desk at (800) 353-4348 before they are put into effect.

Changing any of these items without notifying Dynamic will prevent us from providing technical support to you and can greatly extend the time it takes to resolve technical issues on your system.

# **Dictionary Info**

In Scheduling, is there a way to schedule an appointment if the time slot indicates that it is unavailable?

Although no one can override an appointment if the schedule says that the office is closed, there are 3 different privileges that allow overriding scheduling limitations.

Go to the "Permission Group Dictionary" and select the dictionary entry you would like to modify. Click the "Permissions" tab, click "Miscellaneous Privileges" (and deselect any other permission types to display only "Miscellaneous Privileges"), and scroll through the Available Permission box. There are 3 privileges related to scheduling:

Scheduling – allow overbooking Scheduling – allow unavailable Scheduling – allow constraints

Click the appropriate activities from the "Available Permissions" window to move the permissions to the "Selected Permissions" window. Click "Save." The person who has this modified Permission Group in their related Person Dictionary will now have privileges to override the unavailable appointment slot.

# **Systems Info**

What should we be doing with the Sybase Error Log?

Keep an eye on your Sybase Error Log!

Each time you start SQL Server, messages in the error log provide information on the success (or failure) of the start and the recovery of each database on the server. Subsequent fatal error messages and all kernel error messages are appended to the error log file.

The file is usually located on your RadPlus Server in the \sybase\install directory - named either "sql\_err" or "errorlog." Your Database Administrator should be reviewing this error log periodically to ensure SQL Server has not encountered any problems.

Please do not open this file with notepad until you have viewed the size of the file. Trying to open an enormous file could bring down your server!

Warning! This sql\_err (or error log) file can grow to the physical size of your disk. If the file is large in size, you will need to stop SQL Server (via Sybase Central), delete (or rename) the file in the sybase/install directory and then restart SQL Server. When SQL initializes, it will create a new Sybase error file.

# Update on 3rd party software versions supported by RadPlus

Dynamic's client/server systems integrate many industry-leading software packages into one solution for your radiology information and workflow needs. This requires constant testing and updating by Dynamic to ensure that all pieces of the puzzle work together. Here is an update on the major 3rd party software packages supported by RadPlus.

### **Operating System**

NT 4.0 (recommend SP-4 or SP-6a) for database server, agent machines, and workstations

- AIX 4.3.3 for database server
- Windows 95/98 for workstations only

Windows 2000 is not yet supported, as our 3rd party faxing software does not yet support this platform. Dynamic is working closely with IMECOM to test their Windows 2000 beta release, and we hope to support this platform by the end of the year. Sybase and PowerBuilder are also not yet officially supported under Windows 2000, though we have found no problems in these areas.

#### Database

Sybase 11.0.3 or 11.9.2

Roll out of 11.9 to all RadPlus customers has been put on hold, pending a fix from Sybase to a slowdown of backups using DLT tape drives on NT Servers. Sybase has agreed to continue support to 11.0 for RadPlus customers in the meantime.

#### Word Processor

Visual Writer (new version is called TX Text Control in RadPlus) or Microsoft Office 97 Professional SR-2

Dynamic has tested Office 2000 Professional, and found it to be acceptable except that the RadPlus client installation program does not yet support its new registry structure. The installation program is currently being enhanced to support this. Initially, users of Office 2000 may be required to run with macro security set to "low."

If your site is a candidate for the new and improved "Binderless" form of printing of batches, you may be able to load just MS Word, rather than the Office or Office Professional suite. Dynamic hopes to support this option by the end of this year.

#### **Fax Server Software**

Most RadPlus sites are running version 6.2 of the fax server software from IMECOM. Recently installed sites have a newer 6.41 SP-1 release. We have found the newer release to be more robust. There is no need for sites that have reliable faxing today to switch in the short term. Over time, however, all sites will be converted to the 6.41 SP-1 release in order to stay current. The conversion will require several hours of downtime for the fax server, but will not affect the rest of the RadPlus system. If you are experiencing faxing problems on a 6.2 system, contact your Dynamic representative to schedule an upgrade.

Dynamic is constantly testing new 3<sup>rd</sup> party software and evaluating what works with what. The large number of combinations of components makes this a large and ongoing task, and occasionally dictates that we limit the number of configuration variations that we support. Our goal is to provide our customers with the most dependable configurations possible.

### **InfoMaker Tips**

#### How can I change the date / time format of an object?

Generally, to change the format of an object, in Design view, right click to go to Properties. Then go to the Format tab. For date/time columns, we usually use [shortdate] hh:mm. Using hh:mm will display the time in military (24 hour) format. If you want to change the time format, you can choose from the following:

hh:mm	displays as 21:45	
hhmm	displays as 2145	
h:mm AM/PM	displays as 9:45 PM	
hh:mm A/P	displays as 09:45 P	
h:mm am/pmdisplays as 9:45 pm		

#### Can you explain how to create retrieval arguments?

Providing a selection criteria (or retrieval arguments) to users will minimize creating multiple reports.

For example, someone in the CT Department needs a report displaying the CT procedures for the last week. However, someone in the MRI Department would like the same report, but displaying the MRI procedures for the last month. To prevent creating two different reports, the report writer can provide the users a selection criteria thereby developing only one report.

Here's how to do it:

1. In SQL mode of an InfoMaker report, click Design, Retrieval Arguments and enter the selection criteria as needed. Use the Retrieval Argument list found in RadPlus to create all arguments except dates. This list can be found under the Setup icon, Dynamic Customizer folder, Folder and Items folder, and InfoMaker Wizard Retrieval Argument.

For example, to allow the user to select the date range and procedure status, enter the following:

Specify Retrieval Arguments	×
Argument Position Name Type	ОК

- 2. In the Where clause at the bottom of the screen, select the column that is associated to the retrieval argument. For example, if the user would like to display results that have an arrived status, the column to be used is p\_special\_proc.sprostatus\_id. For the Operator, use "like" to be able to preview all results using the % sign in InfoMaker's retrieval arguments. Right click the Value field and select Arguments; highlight the procedure\_status that was created in step 1. Click Paste.
- 3. Return to Design Mode and insert a computed object by going to the text menu, clicking Objects, Computed Field, and clicking the cursor in the header area. In the Expression field, enter the retrieval name using the following example:

"@retrieval\_name@"

This will display the selection criteria on the report and is recommended for your own troubleshooting purposes. Place a text object in front of the computed object to create a label for the selection criteria.

- 4. Elongate the computed field objects to allow the entire selection criteria to be displayed. For example, if the procedure status includes Completed, Arrived, and Procedure Begun, then the field will need to be long enough for the user's selection criteria. Click Save.
- 5. Click Preview. Since you used "like" as the Operator in step 2, a percentage sign (%) can be inserted in the value field of the popup window. Note the procedure status will not be displayed on the InfoMaker report until it is incorporated into RadPlus.

Hint: if you would like to create a date range, such as for a procedure date, follow the steps listed above. However, in step 1, enter "from" and "to" in front of the same date name. When entering the Value field in the Where clause in step 2, the "from" and "to" retrieval arguments can be used in the same Where clause separated by "and." For example, using procedure dates, the Value field would appear as:

:from\_procedure\_date and :to\_procedure\_date



**Resolution:** The updater cannot run simultaneously with any RadPlus jobs: the "sunshine" icon, interface jobs, scheduled reports, conversions, etc. If any of these are active, they should be shut down by right clicking and selecting Close from all jobs except interface jobs. Use the Interface Manager to shut down interface processors and I/O Handlers. Check with your System Manager prior to shutting anything down or wait until the scheduler is not active.

**Resolution:** The client workstation is unable to find the Central File Repository (CFR), which is where the cocommon.ini file is located. This could be due to the CFR machine being "down." However, it is more likely attributed to no, or intermittent, network connectivity to the CFR. Contact your System Manager to troubleshoot any network related issues.

## Alert Message:



**Resolution:** Although you were previously working in RadPlus, there is no longer a network connection from the client workstation to the database server. You can still navigate through the menus, but cannot access the data. Contact your System Manager to troubleshoot any network related issues.
