Purpose: The principle reason for these instructions is to "disassociate files from an application."

For example, after double-clicking a file in Microsoft Explorer, it opens by default to the wrong application. If a file named testing_file.zip is doubleclicked in Microsoft Explorer, the application that you would like to open the file is Win Zip. However, if the application opened is 7-Zip (and not Win Zip), then the application (7-Zip) should be disassociated from files containing the .zip extension (the suffix after the dot) and reassociated with the proper application (Win Zip).

These basic instructions are to intended to correct the association between the file extensions and their applications.
